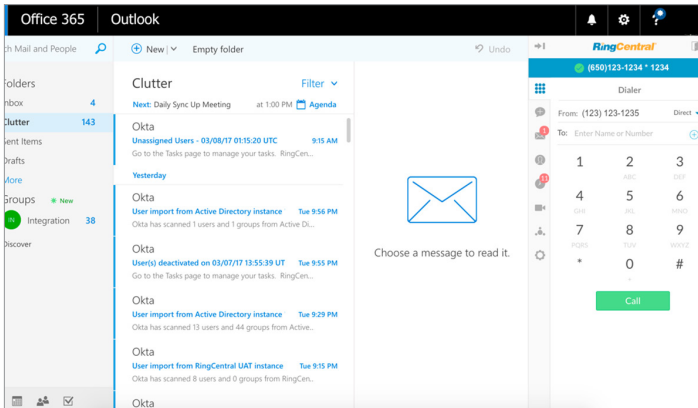

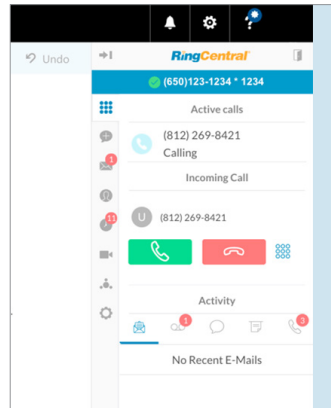
- Make and receive calls directly from Office 365 Mail or Contacts applications.

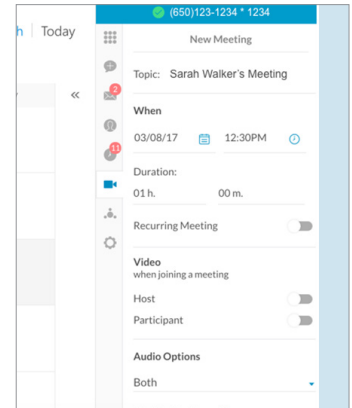
